Medicine that is no longer needed can be donated to a Cancer Drug Repository, where pharmacists help patients in need receive these medications - for free.

Sometimes people with cancer experience hard times trying to get medication they need.



A Cancer Drug Repository Can Help

- Pharmacists can safely provide unused and unopened donated medications to patients in need, for free.
- Medications can be kept from harming the environment.



What Medication Can Be Donated?

- Medication used to treat cancer or the side effects of cancer or chemotherapy.
- Medication unopened and in the original packaging from the manufacturer.
- Medication with an expiration date no less than 6 months from today.



Who is Eligible to Receive Free Cancer Medication?

 Any person with a cancer diagnosis who needs help getting their cancer medication and is a Michigan resident with a valid ID card.



What is YESR?

- A charitable mission organization helping to improve medication access and reduce cancer medication waste.
- A Network of cancer care clinicians creating a sustainable State-wide cancer drug repository.
